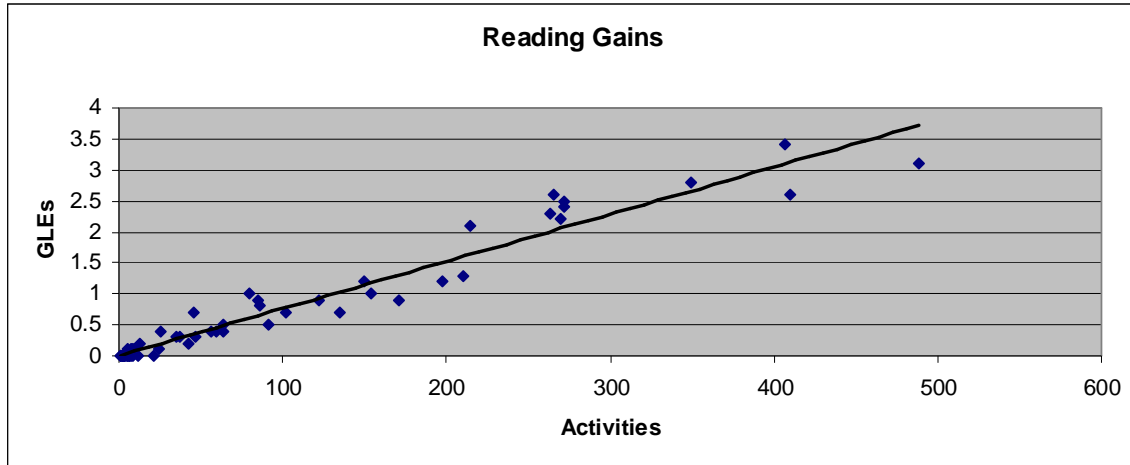




New Century Helps Migrant Students Recover in Collier County Public Schools
