



**New Century Helps Re-Takers Pass FCAT
And Graduate
in
Miami-Dade County Public Schools**



Yvette Holley, the ESOL-ABE Chair Person at Sunset High School, implemented New Century with High School students who had previously failed the FCAT exit test in reading.
